The Master in European Studies at the Asia-Europe Institute (AEI), Universiti Malaya, is a 3-semester programme which prepares students with the requisite knowledge and expertise on the European region.

Why pursue a Master in European Studies?

This programme is the only Master's degree programme of its kind in the region. The courses cover a holistic perspective on the European region's distinctive history, as well as its political, security, and economic experiences. It provides students with a unique "outsiders'" perspective which is complemented with "insiders'" expertise from top European academic institutes. The programme also provides students with comparative knowledge of ASEAN, to generate greater appreciation of commonalities and differences between Asia and Europe, and their representative regional organisations. A distinct feature of the programme is that it offers a blend of historical, modern international relations, regionalism, and political economic perspectives. In doing so, the programme pays due attention to the European Union (EU) and its affiliate regional and inter-regional initiatives, making it a one of its kind Master's degree programme on European Studies in Asia.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Academic Qualification:

Bachelor's degree (CGPA 3.00 and above)

Language Requirements:

International Applicant - If the applicant's degree is from a university where the medium of instruction is not English, a minimum score in one of the following standard English Language tests is required:

- TOEFL (paper-based) – 550 or higher
- TOEFL (computer-based) – 213 or higher
- TOEFL (internet-based) – 80 or higher
- IELTS (Academic) – Band 5.5 or higher
