## Entry Requirements

**Academic Qualification:** Bachelor's degree (CGPA 3.00 and above)

### Language Requirements:

International Applicant - If the applicant's degree is from a university where the medium of instruction is not English, a minimum score in one of the following standard English Language tests is required:

- TOEFL (paper-based) – 550 or more
- TOEFL (computer-based) – 213 or more
- TOEFL (internet-based) – 80 or more
- IELTS (Academic) – Band 5.5 or higher
